Proceedings User Guide

- All conference presentations and extras can be accessed from the menu system. Click on a presentation link to access it. Presentations will open in a separate browser window or a new tab in the current browser window.
- When finished viewing a presentation, close the browser window by selecting File/Close or click the close icon:
 in the top left corner of the browser window.
 If the file was opened as a tab in the same browser window use File/Close Tab or press Ctrl + W to close the tab.

PDFs

- Conference presentations are primarily in PDF format. Adobe Reader can be downloaded at https://get.adobe.com/reader/.
- Presentations and that are downloaded to your desktop will load and display more quickly. Some files are large and may take a while to open.
- PDF presentations can be downloaded for full screen viewing by right-clicking a link and choosing Save Target As... or by opening the presentation and then choosing File/Save As... to save it to your desktop.
- Press the down arrow and up arrow keys to navigate presentations. Clicking with your mouse anywhere in a PDF presentation will also advance the presentation.
- Many PDF presentations include presenter's comments. These comments can be viewed
 in Adobe Reader by selecting View/Comment/Annotations. This will open a comment
 viewing window on the right side of your Reader. Pro versions of Acrobat will have
 variations in how the comments are accessed through the menu system.

Videos

• When video is available it may be in a variety of formats. If problems are encountered, try downloading the file by right-clicking on the link, choosing "Save target as...," and saving to your desktop. You can then open the file using the QuickTime Player, Windows Media Player or any compatible movie player.
